Rev. Dr. Errol E. Leslie is the founding pastor of Grace and Mercy Ministries Inc. in Palm Bay, Florida where he presently resides. He is originally from Jamaica and in August of 1995 along with his family he immigrated to the USA. Prior to that, he had worked as a Methodist minister in the Caribbean. After transferring to the United States, he continued his ministry at five separate congregations within the United Methodist Church in the states of Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Florida.

Early in his life, he found that he had a natural and innate love for music and drama. Over the duration of his ministry, he wrote several plays and skits with a Christian message. Among these productions are two full-length Christmas musicals which are based on the Christmas narrative as we know it from the Bible, but he added some imaginary scenes and characters which are not detailed in the biblical narrative. He is also a singer and a self-taught musician with the gift of being able to play several musical instruments. As such, for a long time, his family participated in a reggae gospel music ministry where they were able to minster in song to several audiences all over Jamaica and in several states within the USA. During the process, they were able to release three separate musical CDS. More recently, he also released a solo acapella album comprising older gospel songs. For this project, he was able to use what he deems to be his God-given gift of creating harmony to lay several separate vocal tracks using only his voice. The net effect is that on the project, he created the feel of an all-male acapella group using just his voice alone. This latest acapella CD is titled "The Old Time Religion" and is available on all the major musical platforms including Spotify, iTunes, Apple, and Amazon.

He received his BA in theology from the University of the West Indies, Mona Campus, Kingston, Jamaica, in 1978 and his Doctor of Ministry (D Min) from Columbia Theological Seminary, Decatur, Georgia, in 1991.

He has written two separate books, and both were triggered or inspired by different events in his life. His latest book is the first in a series entitled CHRISTIAN BIBLE DRAMA SERIES.

The original publisher, *Christian Faith Publishing* describes it as an engaging pair of complete musical productions.

The summary of the release is also described as: Two Musicals: Same Story, Same Message, Same Jesus, Different Plots" in which author Rev. Dr. Errol E. Leslie offers a duo of dramas that can be used in full or as individual scenes to enrich the celebration and study of key components of the Christian faith.

Mary and Joseph would have had parents too, so how did they come into the picture? What were their immediate thoughts when news of the miracle pregnancy unfolded? There might have been uncertainty and confusion, even among the people of God. One may even assume that there may have been gossips in that society who, like some persons today, just enjoyed embellishing stories which sounded juicy.

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Rev. Dr. Errol E. Leslie creates two storylines that portray the events leading up to the birth of the Lord Jesus Christ in his book, Christian Bible Drama Series, Christmas Edition. This book is a collection of two dramas with the same message: the birth of Jesus Christ. Despite the differences in the storylines of both stories, certain key characters and events remain constant, such as the villainous character of King Herod and the saving power of God.

The stories involve the divine conception of a poor young girl, Mary, who was, at the time, betrothed to a young carpenter named Joseph. She gets that this may affect her engagement with him, but with the help of an angel, Joseph still takes her as his wife. When they eventually give birth to the child, King Herod does everything within his power to see that the ancient prophecy about the child does not come to pass.

Leslie uses this book to teach about the origin of Christmas and the importance of the celebration of Christmas in the Christian faith. The book has a touch of humor. For example, in the first story, despite the depletion of gold in Herod's country, the three wise men he sent to visit baby Jesus took gold to give him as one of the presents.

There are certain positive aspects of the book. First, the book is written in a simple and understandable language. Second, the author uses the book to teach certain lessons to Christians. For example, the author taught that God will not allow a person to be in a situation that the person cannot handle. This is exemplified in the story involving Mary when she was afraid of how Joseph would react to the news of her pregnancy. The book also teaches that God will certainly do everything to guide His own. Despite King Herod's decree for the

killing of male children under the age of two, God still saved baby Jesus. Another positive aspect of the book is that it contains songs that can be sung independently during Christmas, and the author also provides the sol-fa notations of some songs.

I only found one error in the book. This shows that the book was professionally edited. Added to the positives identified above, I will be giving the book five out of five stars. The negative aspect I found was insufficient to deduct a star from my rating. I recommend this book to all Christians, especially those interested in Christmas dramas.
